1. Click the "New" button to begin a new puppet show.



- 2. Follow the on-screen prompts to choose the desired puppets, backgrounds, and props.
- 3. Use the buttons at the top to start and stop the recording, to save and share, and to navigate the app:



- 4. To record a show:
- a. Click the red circle.
- b. Hold your finger on a puppet, talk, and move the puppet around.
- c. Repeat, touching each puppet as you want it to "speak."
- d. Click the "square" button to stop the recording.
- 5. When you're done recording, you can:
- a. Click the "Share" button to upload it to photos or YouTube.
- b. Click the "Save" button for replay on the iPad.

Notes / Helpful Hints

- o In the "Settings" area, you can change the pitch of each character's voice. A "slider" button lets you choose from low to normal to high.
- o To upload to YouTube, you'll need to create an account. Just go to www.youtube.com and click the "Create an account" link in the upper right corner.
